Cincinnati boasts a surprisingly low cost of living: about 12% less expensive than similar cities. The cost of housing is 24% below the national average.

The Cincinnati region offers high-quality educational options. Cincinnati is home to 13 of the top private schools in Ohio and 10 of the top public schools in Ohio. There are also robust co-op and hybrid schooling opportunities. Nearby higher-education choices include: University of Cincinnati, Xavier University, University of Dayton, Northern Kentucky University, Cincinnati State, Mount St. Joseph University, Miami University, and Thomas Moore University.

HEALTHCARE

Your healthcare needs are well-supported in the Cincinnati region, home to multiple top-tier hospital systems including The Christ Hospital, Mercy Health, TriHealth, UC Health, and St. Elizabeth Healthcare. Families also benefit from access to two nationally-recognized pediatric hospitals: Cincinnati Children's Hospital, consistently ranked #1 or #2 in the nation, and Dayton Children's Hospital.
